Dr Sharpe was very impressed with Cherryz recovery....!!! She couldn't believe how quickly she has bounced back from her stroke, she is encouraging Cherry to get back into school as soon as she is able to, not on a fulltime basis but if only for an hour a couple of days a week that would be a great start. So we talked and are going to work on getting Cherry back into Macauley again, slowly..... She's still feeling a little hesitant about going back in there and I only want her to go if she feels comfortable. They still could not explain how and why the stroke happened, all her blood tests came back normal and the best news ( well Cherry and I thought so) she gained great weight 40.81kgs (never been up this high before....LOL) and she stands at 1.43cm, we had massive smiles just to hear those numbers, coz you know how long and hard it had been for Cherry to put on weight and growth...!!! So on the neurological side, she has improved a great deal physically, mentally it will take up to 12months to get the little things right with her reading and writing and emotional side of things, but we are happy to know that she has recovered well so far...!!! please give the team our Love.
