

Cure Kids Walk on the Wild Side Conditions of Entry

For the purposes of these conditions of entry, "**Participant**" means any member of the public that participates and/or competes in the Walk on the Wild Side event in 2011 ("**Event**") organised by Cure Kids Limited ("**Cure Kids**").

The Participant agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) the Participant is over the age of 16 as at 13 November 2011. Participants under the age of 16 as at 14 November 2011 may be accepted for entry in the Event at the sole discretion of Cure Kids and provided that he or she is under the supervision of a parent or guardian;
- (b) the Participant will endeavour to raise a minimum of \$300.00 for the Event;
- (c) all money raised for the Event is the property of Cure Kids;
- (d) the Participant will act in a safe and prudent manner during the Event and not in any way that could be harmful to Cure Kids or its sponsors, including, but not limited to, reputational damage;
- (e) the Participant is medically fit and able to participate and/or compete in the Event and that he or she has disclosed (or will disclose upon entry) any pre-existing medical condition(s) to Cure Kids. Although Cure Kids have taken every reasonable measure to ensure the Participant's health and safety, the Participant is responsible for his or her own health and safety. If the Participant has a pre-existing medical condition that may require attention in the Event, it is his or her responsibility to get clearance from his or her doctor prior to the Event;
- (f) any information provided to Cure Kids in relation to any pre-existing medical condition(s) may be held and used by Cure Kids in connection with the race and disclosed to emergency service providers where necessary;
- (g) the Participant is entitled to have access to, or require correction of, any information held by Cure Kids that is related to him or her; and
- (h) the Participant consents to his or her image being used, without compensation, for marketing and promotional purposes by Cure Kids and/or its sponsors for the duration of the Event and for the pre-Event and post-Event promotional activities.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Participant agrees not to hold Cure Kids liable for:

- (a) any injury, harm, disease or damage to health or loss of any description of life, whether physical, mental or otherwise (including mental or nervous shock or distress) suffered by the Participant during the course of, or as a consequence of, or in any way associated with, the Event; or
- (b) any direct or indirect damage, cost, expense or consequential loss suffered by, or in respect of, any property of the Participant; or
- (c) any action related to the organisation, promotion, safety or staging of the Event including, but not limited to, any action that could give rise to a claim under statute, contract, in tort or otherwise as a direct or indirect result of any act, neglect or omission of Cure Kids.

Notwithstanding any of the above, Cure Kids retains sole discretion to refuse entry in the Event of a Participant for any reason.

I, the Participant, acknowledge that I have read and understood:

- (a) the conditions of entry for the Event as set out above; and
 - (b) the race rules for the Event,
- (together, the "**Terms and Conditions**"), and agree to be bound by, and act in accordance with, the Terms and Conditions in all dealings between Cure Kids and me.
