It is best to travel through Swanson, and follow Scenic Drive North for approximately 4km before turning right onto Te Henga Road. This road winds its way all the way down to Bethells Beach.

Please don't forget to make sure you bring all the gear you need, as well as some snacks and some cash for coffee/food! There's no cellphone reception at Bethells Beach, so no eftpos available.
